- Never boo or whistle in the auditorium; we show our appreciation by applause.
- Be willing to help others.
- Be friendly and courteous.
- Do not take anything that does not belong to us.

5. We are expected to follow safety rules throughout the school.

This means:

- No playing in the bathroom or the hallways.
- No running in the lunchroom, hallways, or stairways.
- Use equipment for its intended purposes.
