

Accessing Horizon Client for Chrome



Step 1. After logging into the Chromebook, locate and open the VMware Horizon Client for Chrome application from main toolbar at the bottom of the screen. Icon below



Step 2. Select the (+). Icon below / **If you are not prompted with a (+) icon. Please proceed directly to Step 4.**



Step 3. You will be required to enter the name of the connection server. Enter **desktop.tenafly.k12.nj.us** in the “Connection Server Field” click Connect. “Connection Server Description” is optional and **does not** need to be populated. Before and after value entered below:


