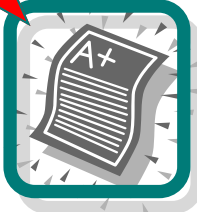

- 3** After you finish your current unit, you should pick up the next unit using the new curriculum.

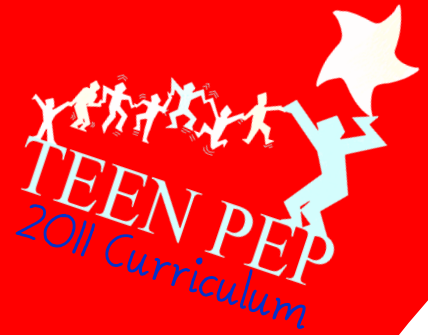
